# First Week from 13 to 19 January

## Get to know the Canary Botanical Garden “Viera y Clavijo” and the Historic Center of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria (Triana and Vegueta)

**Day:** January 16, 2025

**Place:** Las Palmas de Gran Canaria

**Time:** 15:30-20:00 h

**Activity:** Interpreted visit to the Botanical Garden to learn about and discover the endemic and native species of the Canary Islands, followed by an exciting game of clues through the Historic Center of the capital of the island of Gran Canaria



## Connecting in Nature

**Day:** January 15, 2025

**Place:** Nature Classroom “Lomo Jurgón” (Aruacas)

**Time:** 16:00-19:00 h

**Activity:** Path interpreted by the surroundings of the “Lomo Jurgón” Nature Classroom, followed by group dynamics of welcome and teamwork to enhance the creation of links and ties from the first moment



## Summit Route (Artenara and Tejeda)

**Day:** January 18, 2025

**Place:** Summit and center of the island

**Time:** 09:00-17:30 h

**Activity:** Route through the towns and municipalities belonging to the Gran Canaria Biosphere Reserve (RBGC), with a stop at Risco Caído and the Sacred Mountains of Gran Canaria (declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in July 2019)



# Second Week from 20 to 26 January

## Kayak and Snorkel (Las Canteras Beach)

**Day:** January 21, 2025

**Place:** Las Palmas de Gran Canaria

**Time:** 16:00-18:30 h

**Activity:** Sports, aquatic and educational activities for environmental awareness (Kayaking, Collaborative Gymkhana, Snorkeling, Microplastics Workshop) to discover and enjoy the marine diversity on Las Canteras Beach



## Visit the natural pools of Bañaderos and get to know the Historic Center of Arucas

**Day:** January 23, 2025

**Place:** Bañaderos, Arucas

**Time:** 15:30-19:30 h

**Activity:** Visit to the natural pools of Bañaderos with a dip included, followed by a treasure hunt through the Historic Center of Arucas to learn about the idiosyncrasy of the place



## Southern Route (Maspalomas Dunes and Puerto de Mogán)

**Day:** January 25, 2025

**Place:** Southern part of the Island

**Time:** 09:30-18:00 h

**Activity:** Route through the southern part of the island of Gran Canaria, with stops at the Maspalomas Dunes Natural Reserve, the Charca de Maspalomas, and Puerto de Mogán, known for its canals, bougainvillea flowers and picturesque passageways.



# Third Week from 27 to 31 January

## Northwest Route (Gáldar)

**Day:** January 28, 2025

**Place:** Northwest of the island

**Time:** 15:30-20:00 h

**Activity:** Route through Gáldar, where we explore the Cueva Pintada, a Guanche archaeological treasure, the imposing Church of Santiago, and the majestic and centenary Drago de Gáldar, a symbol of longevity and history in the municipality



## Farewell at Las Canteras Beach - Confital Bay

**Day:** January 30, 2025

**Place:** Las Palmas de Gran Canaria

**Time:** 16:00-18:00 h

**Activity:** Collaborative farewell in the area of Confital Bay, on the capital's coast. We will enjoy a relaxing and interpreted walk, followed by group dynamics and a magical and beautiful sunset that will seal these days with unforgettable memories and experiences.
