



SEMINAR WEEK

The seminar week will take us to Dhaka, the capital of Bangladesh. From there we will begin our journey into the rural landscapes, cultural heritage, and educational initiatives of Narail and Rudrapur:

- > to Narail, visit to the SM Sultan Art School and meetings with students and teachers, visit of building site and exploration of the riverine landscape,
- > to Rudrapur, visit of Anna Heringer's Meti School, Desi Building, and Anandaloy Building, participation in cultural activities and community events,
- > return to Dhaka, visits to markets, public spaces, and buildings such as the Bait Ur Rouf Jame Mosque by Marina Tabassum

COSTS Total costs ca. 1'600 CHF; flight ca. 1'200 CHF (depending on carrier and connections); visa on arrival ca. 50 CHF (for Swiss/Austrian/German residents); accommodation ca. 15 CHF/night; transport during week ca. 200 CHF; daily costs for food and entry tickets of 10 CHF.
