How would you transform your own campus? A university campus is more than a collection of buildings. It is a shared landscape where learning, everyday life, biodiversity and public space meet. How can design respond to climate change while balancing the needs of students, researchers, neighbours and visitors?

The studio explores how urban design and landscape architecture can shape a more resilient, inclusive and inspiring campus. Students will develop a long-term spatial vision that integrates ecological thinking, everyday uses and the identity of the University of Liechtenstein. Developed in collaboration with the Landscape Architecture programme at OST Rapperswil, the studio offers a unique interdisciplinary design experience.
